


Brad Gunderson passed away peacefully on December 20, 2024.



Salem Lutheran Church Council Meeting Notes - Dec. 10th, 2024

Old Business:

Trim around the windows has been completed. West entrance door has been installed and new keys for council members have been provided. The new door still needs a tension rod, so it doesn't catch in the wind. The locks are fixed on the east entrance and one key works on both locks. Once a council member is done with their term, they will pass their key to the new council member as the keys will not be duplicated.

Shirley met with a few photographers regarding family photos for the Salem book. She will follow up on scheduling a time and get confirmation on who will be taking the pictures. Discussion around creating the book and printing options.

Bathroom remodel will need to be scheduled sometime in January. Council members may need to help on install of toilets, vanities and accessories if needed. Flooring will need to be done first.

**New Business:** 

Review of current council members for 2025 as Toni will be at the end of term.

Door in pastors room needs to be replaced, no decision made. Back entry door should be painted but we will table this until spring cleanup day.

There was an email from Bonny regarding Toiletries drive for Inter Country but due to the short period of time to notify members, we elected to push this out until Jan/Feb. Dec. 24th service, Vincent and Shirley will usher. Christmas program is Dec. 14th with potluck after. No church services on Dec. 22nd. Discussion on holding a recorded church service and reaching out to Rev. Rebel Hurd for options.

Storage is needed for Sunday school supplies to keep the utilities closet free for easy access for maintenance.

Council is reviewing Salem Membership list. There are 135 confirmed members, but some could be considered as Inactive. Inactive status is defined as Member has not attended church or contributed financial in 3 years. They will remain a member of Salem church but will have an Inactive status until one of the forementioned criteria changes.

2025 Budget numbers were reviewed and motion to approve/approved by: 1st Josh, 2nd Kyle.

Old Business: RLC Social Services is having internet connection issues when they use the building. Cheryl was

asked if we'd be willing to upgrade the internet speed or router and they would reimburse some of the cost. Cheryl has called Garden Valley to check our router/internet speed and will also talk to them about Managed Wi-Fi.

New Business: The steps need repair. The caution tape that is on the carpet is slippery and we will look into a different solution until it can be repaired. Zion has received a donation of 3 smoke alarms and 1 carbon monoxide detector from the Oklee Fire Dept. Cheryl bought 2 new fire extinguishers for the church. She will also talk to the fire department and to see about getting our current extinguishers inspected. The newsletters have been arriving late for some people. The instant alert system didn't notify some people that church was canceled last Sunday. Sandy Lee was approved for a **Thrivent Action Grant for the Sunday School** peanut/candy bags that will be handed out after the Sunday School program on Sunday, December 15th. We discussed inviting more people to church and Sunday School. Sarah has been working on a mailer and will get the information to the council.

Our annual meeting will be on January 26. Sunday school will be at 9:30, church is at 10:30 with Potluck after.
