I wanted to take this opportunity to share with you some information on the CPKC Holiday Train. The train will be stopping in Plummer on Sunday, December 15th around 6:00/6:15p.m.

The Vocal Artists that will be preforming are Seaforth and Alana Springsteen.

We will be collecting donations (cash and food) for the food shelf that night and any time at our office. We also receive a cash donation from CPKC in the form of a big check-which we don't actually get to keep. That donation is split with the Red Lake Falls Food shelf.

Each year we are asked to report the number of pounds and cash that is collected leading up to the event to CPKC. It helps them track how much of a difference the train makes coming to our community.

A fun fact is ...there are actually two Holiday trains, one that travels throughout Canada and one that comes to the U.S.

The Holiday Train has helped raise over \$24.3 million and over 5.3 million pounds of food since 1999 to help those in need in Canada and the U.S. The trains runs from November 21st to December 20th.



Parish Board Meeting

Parish Board meeting November 19, 2024 7:00 p.m.

Roll call: Cheryl O'Neill, Gin Berns, David Hofstad, Conway Hamm and Josh Vettleson. Missing was Kyle Vettleson. Treasurer/Secretary Bonny Cote.

Cheryl O., opened the meeting. Minutes were looked at and approved by David H. and Josh V. Carried.

Financial report was given by Bonny Cote, and was approved by Gin B and Conway H. Carried.

Budget was then gone through for 2025. Bonny C. was asked to talk to the City about the services since no one lives in the parsonage at this time. Bonny informed the board that the Parsonage & Zion Church are considered one.

New Business: Bonny C asked for a raise. She has passed on a raise for four years and felt that the Parish could afford one now and due to no permanent pastor and has more duties. The board decided on \$800 a year, motion by Conway H, seconded by Josh V. Carried.

A motion was made to forgive Zion and Salem December's payment to the Parish. David H/Gin B, carried.

Bonny has been scheduling for December pulpit supply. She has most of December completed. But December 22 was still open and it has been suggested to not have church on that day and instead focus on Christmas Eve as a Joint Service at Salem at 4 p.m. Also not to have service on Christmas day. She has downloaded the new list and it has fewer people than before but will start calling for January.

The Annual meeting will be held at Salem on January 19th which is a joint service. The parishners from Zion can go downstairs and enjoy the pot luck while Salem is having their meeting. The following week, January 26th will be Zion's Annual meeting.

Meeting was adjourned by David H & Josh V. The Lords Prayer was said in closing.

The Next meeting will be Tuesday, January 9th at 7:00 p.m.
