Spring Conference Gathering Highlights



Conference 7-Spring Gathering was held Monday, April 8, 2024, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Fergus Falls. The theme verses were Proverbs 4:26, "Give careful thought to the paths of your feet and be steadfast in all our ways" and Proverbs 3:6, "In all your ways submit to him and he will make your paths straights." Pastor Eliza Johnson provided a devotional based on Proverbs 8 reminding us that the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom and daily living with integrity is with God's wisdom. We are to live in God's way and only desire what God desires for us. The opening hymn, "Thine is the Glory" was sung. Music was provided by violinist Val Johnson and pianist Susie Sanner. The keynote speaker, Pastor Lynn Melchior presented a PowerPoint showing her Pilgrimage to Israel with other pastors in January of 2023. She showed the sites she visited which depicted the life of Jesus with Bible references listed. Pastor Lynn installed Cindy Kunde as Conference 7 Financial Recorder. The closing hymn "I'm So Glad Jesus Lifted Me" was sung. The meeting concluded with praying the Lord's Prayer and Benediction.

Ingredients

- 8 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1 small yellow onion diced 16 ounces frozen broccoli
- 1 teaspoon onion powder optional
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder optional
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 10 ounces condensed cream of chicken soup (store bought or homemade)
- 1 cup milk (I used skim)
- 1 cup instant rice
- · 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese divided
- 1 pound Gold'n Plump Boneless Skinless Chicken Breasts diced (uncooked)
- 1 cup fried onions

Instructions

- 1. Preheat your oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 9 by 13 inch casserole dish with cooking spray.
- 2. In a large sauce pan, melt the butter, Add the onion, and cook until translucent, about 5 minutes. Stir in the broccoli, and cook until no longer frozen, about 5 minutes.
